Service Leadership Development

Working directly with Downtown Ministries Director of Communications and Director of the Emerging Leaders Internship Program, Grace Redmond, to provide key "hands on" service to departments throughout Downtown Ministries as key needs arise:



- Provide additional support as needed to our Directors and staff throughout events planned and weekly administrative tasks
- Attend and engage at organization-wide outreach and engagement events
- Participate in other service leadership opportunities in “boots on the ground” work within the Downtown Ministries landscape. This could look like serving as a group leader at Downtown Academy’s Afterschool Program, maintaining partner food resource programs (Food Bank, Shared Table, etc.) programming needs (pickups and deliveries), helping manage key programming inventory across multiple program facilities or even serving meals and supply management at Our Daily Bread Community Kitchen and other duties as assigned with our programming landscape
- Partner with the Executive Office of Downtown Ministries to support pertinent administrative needs in and for our programming, thus directly making it possible for us to provide the academic and personal development needed to see the children of the next generation thrive
- Provide key support in program evaluation, getting a bird’s eye view on the needed skills to develop and executive strategic programming goals, vision, and ultimately success in partnership with program directors
- Participate in Darkness2Light (child sexual abuse prevention) training and Leadership Development seminars like Bridges out of Poverty (program materials to be provided)

Community Involvement / Engagement, Networking, and Partnership Development

Working with Downtown Ministries Director of Communications and the Director of the Emerging Leaders Internship Program, Grace Redmond, and our Deputy Executive Director, Jesse Pilkenton to understand Downtown Ministries programs to assist in helping create opportunities for informed public understanding, further develop partnerships and media outlet appearances that will grow our organizational efforts.

- Carry the culture and mission of Downtown Ministries as an ambassador within your personal network, classes and organizations of interest

Development Strategy & Grant Writing

Direct, hands-on research and strategic planning with our Department of Development, Cary Rivers and Deputy Executive Director, Jesse Pilkenton

- Assist in completing grant proposals and researching new grant opportunities
- Strategize with internship coordinators on engagement and communications rhythm to keep donors connected to the work of Downtown Ministries year-round
- Organize and refine contact management software, analyze and update client relationship management (CRM) tool, data gathering procedures, and reports
- Research and propose spaces for new donor engagement
- Work cross functionally alongside our grant writing efforts to ensure that all grant requirements are met in a timely, organized and functional manner in conjunction with our established grant writing calendar
- Receive mentorship and development from our Leadership Circle in the skills related to development and fundraising
